The children in Bumbles have been talking about Harvest festival this week. Looking at different types of fruits and vegetables, they discussed which of these they liked to eat at home. In craft they explored shapes and colours by making their own printing pictures.

The children have been developing their imagination and social interaction by participating in role-play using doctors and dental resources. This has been a great opportunity to promote good oral health and led onto other conversations about the importance of health and hygiene.
