# Education

Our setting is registered and inspected by OFSTED and we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework. Children's development is monitored regularly and additional support is accessed when required. We have close links to Essex Child and Family Wellbeing Service and other qualified professionals to ensure your child reaches their full potential. Children are given the opportunity to extend their knowledge with challenging activities to solve problems which promote self confidence. All qualified staff complete Paediatric First Aid Training and some have additional qualifications including Autism Awareness, Speech & Language and SENCo.

Starting Pre-School is a big step for most children and we do all we can at Springfield Bees to help make the experience as positive as possible. Staff support personal, social and emotional development by forming strong relationships with their Key Children. We provide experiences and activities that are challenging but achievable and opportunities for children to reflect on successes and their own talents. Circle times are the ideal opportunity for children to talk in small groups about something they are interested in or have done which helps develop their self esteem. Our persona doll, Freddie, helps the children learn about their own emotions and understand the needs of others. We firmly believe that children learn best when their emotional needs are met.
